

TEAM ROSTER AGREEMENT

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of Hallmark Sports Club, Ltd. (hereinafter "HSC") providing an area to practice, play or participate in an athletic event, the registering Coach and Team members jointly agree to pay the then current fees for the session or activity for which the Team participates, to abide by the Rules of Play and the arena rules for public conduct.

1. Upon submission of a team for registration, a registration form or this Team Roster Agreement, the registering Coach and Team may withdraw the registration up to two weeks prior to the first game and receive a full refund of any deposit made. Thereafter, the Coach/Team is obligated to pay the entire registration fee and no refund of the same shall be due or required to be given. HSC reserves the right to limit the number registrations it accepts. If a Team registers for any indoor session and then subsequently registers for another or second indoor session, this Roster Agreement shall be deemed by HSC & the registering Coach to have been automatically extended. Should a team change coaches, it shall be the responsibility of both coaches to ensure that any and all team fees which are due are paid. To release a coach of his or her responsibility for paying registration or team fees, when another person assumes the responsibility of being the Coach, the out-going coach must insure a new Roster Agreement is prepared, signed & submitted to HSC by the new coach.
2. All Teams are required to designate a Coach and the Coach must execute this Agreement. By so doing, the Coach is verifying the proof of age, attesting to the accuracy of all player information, that all minor players have parental permission to play and the Coaches will be the responsible parties for the payment of the team fees and all matters concerning the Team.
3. Non-rostered individuals must be added to this Team Roster Agreement prior to being allowed to participate in any activity or event. If not, the Coach, or other persons authorizing the participation, shall be responsible for the conduct and/or harm or injury caused by or to any such non-rostered individual.
4. All participants are highly encouraged to obtain complete medical examinations prior to engaging in strenuous physical activity. All teams/participants are solely responsible for their own medical/physical conditions and for obtaining any insurance which they may desire to obtain to insure against injury to person or property. The signing Parent for a minor hereby grants to the Coach the limited right, in loco parentis, to obtain emergency medical treatment for such minor.
5. HSC reserves the right, in its sole opinion and judgment, to request any or all members of a Team to immediately leave or depart from the premises and to suspend any team from athletic competition as a result of improper conduct by one or more of the team members.
6. **WAIVER OF LIABILITY:** By signing the Roster and/or participating in an event it is fully understood there is a risk of harm to ourselves (and/or children) associated with participating in a soccer game or other athletic activity. Liability for injuries to person or property against HSC, its employees, assigns, representatives and/or lessor, is hereby expressly waived, and HSC is hereby released from any and all claims for injuries, damages or harm to persons or property, absent gross negligence by HSC, its employees, agents or representatives, and resulting from our presence (or our invitees' presence) upon the premises or participation in an athletic event, practice, contest or any other activity or event whatsoever & located in or about the premises known as 10850 W. Laraway Rd., Frankfort, IL. Except as provided by law, HSC and/or its lessor, shall not be liable to any lessee, licensee, invitee or athletic event participant for any damage or injury to person or property occasioned by the failure of HSC and/or its lessor for the design or condition of repair of the premises. Further, HSC and/or its lessor, are released from liability for any and all injury which may result due to the intentional, willful or inappropriate behavior of others, including other participants in athletic events, lessees, licensees or invitees. It is acknowledged and understood the persons directly responsible for human conduct in an athletic event/contest are the referee, the coaches and the participants themselves. Referees are independent contractors engaged to enforce and apply the recognized rules of play requiring a working knowledge of the rules and many judgment calls. It is acknowledged and agreed it is the responsibility of the participants and/or coaches to immediately cease participation in any event wherein there are differences of opinions, concerning the judgment being exercised by a referee in calling an athletic contest, and which could reasonably or foreseeably lead to accident and/or injury to any of the participants. After cessation of participation, a written statement must be registered with HSC concerning the exercise of judgment used by the referee and a review will be conducted to determine whether to reschedule the event.
7. The Team (parents of minors) agree to pay to the Coach their share of the fees or other charges which are due and the Coach shall be jointly and severally liable for the payment of any and all fees, fines and/or or amounts due to HSC. Further, HSC shall be entitled to charge and receive reasonable attorney's fees and court costs in the event all fees or payments are not made in a timely manner.
8. It is the responsibility of the Coach to have all Team members to sign this Team Roster Agreement. Any Team member under the age of 18 years must have his/her parent or legal guardian sign this Agreement to authorize his/her participation.
